
The 7 respegt rules

Requirements for respeggt laying hen farms



All employees must know and follow the respeggt rules for rearing respeggt hens.





The respeggt laying hens must **never** be mixed with conventional hens.






The respeggt flock passport must be hung up in a clearly visible place on the respeggt chicks' housing entrance door.



The clutches of the respeggt laying hens must always be collected **separately** from conventional eggs. They must then separately from conventional eggs be transported and sorted internally, and packed on trays which are then to be placed on pallets.





The relevant documents such as delivery notes, transport documents and invoices must always be marked with **FoCC** (Free of Chick Culling) or the FoCC document stamp.

The **producer code** is stamped onto the **belly side** of the eggs as the respeggt stamp is placed on the head side of the eggs at the packing centre.
